### INVITATION

Boxing Federation of Russia and the Organizing Committee has a pleasure to invite your boxing team to take part in the EUROPEAN SCHOOLBOYS CHAMPIONSHIPS, to be held in the city of Anapa, Russia.

#### 1. TOURNAMENT DATES

From 28 September (arrival day) to 04 October (departure day) 2009.

#### 2. VENUE FOR COMPETITION

Sport Palace «Kubanskaya Niva», address: 22, Yuzhny Prospekt, Vityazevo, city of Anapa, Krasnodar Region, Russia.

#### 3. RULES AND EVENTS OF COMPETITION

Championships will be held according to the International Competition Rules of AIBA in 18 weight categories: 38,5 kg, 40 kg, 41,5 kg, 43 kg, 44,5 kg, 46 kg, 48 kg, 50 kg, 52 kg, 54 kg, 56kg, 59 kg, 62 kg, 65 kg, 68 kg, 72 kg, 76 kg, +76 kg.

Only boxers born in 1995-1996 (by the year of birth) can participate in the Championships. Bouts will consist of 3 rounds of 1,5 minutes with 1 minute rest between rounds.

#### Each boxer should present:

- AIBA Record book with updated annual medical check
- Passport or ID
- Competition vest in red and blue colours

#### Each National team should take with it:

- National Flag
- National Anthem (MP3, CD or cassette)

#### 4. EVENT PROGRAM

28 September, Monday	day of arrival
29 September, Tuesday	weight in and draw Opening Ceremony Preliminaries
30 September, Wednesday	preliminaries
01 October, Thursday	¼ finals
02 October, Friday	½ finals
03 October, Saturday	finals, Closing Ceremony
04 October, Sunday	day of departure

#### 5. TEAM COMPOSITION

##### a) Boxers:

Each European National Association/Federation are eligible to nominate ONE Schoolboy boxer in each of 18 weight categories. One reserve per weight category may be entered in the final entry form. Only reserve athletes that have been entered are allowed as replacements on

the day of the general weigh-in.

b) Officials :

Each European National Association/Federation can take :

1-4 athletes	3 officials
5-8 athletes	4 officials
9-13 athletes	5 officials
14-18 athletes	6 officials

### 6. REFEREES / JUDGES

Each national team can take one AIBA/ EUBC Referee/Judge.

### 7. FINANCIAL CONDITIONS

a) Official delegations :

- Each National Association/Federation cover travel expenses for athletes and officials to/from the city of Anapa, Russia and back to own country.
- ACCOMMODATION: all athletes and officials will be accommodated with full board at Astoria Hotel at the following costs:
  - **60 EUROS per person per day in single occupancy**
  - **50 EUROS per person per day in double occupancy**
- All participants should pay for their accommodation and meals to the Organizers upon arrival to the Hotel.
- All National Associations/ Federations should provide all members of the teams with medical insurances.

b) Extra persons :

Each extra guest should pay for accommodation with full board:

- **60 EUROS per person per day in single occupancy**
- **50 EUROS per person per day in double occupancy**

We kindly ask you to inform Organizers about extra persons in advance. The acceptance of extra guests will be subject to availability of rooms, provided these are reserved with the Organizing Committee on the same date as the closing of final entries.

### 8. TRANSPORTATION

a) Airports :

All participating teams should arrive to the airport of Anapa, Russia, where it will be met by the Organizers.

b) Local transportation :

Organizing committee will provide for participants local transportation during the Championships, including transfers from Airport to the Hotel and back.

### 9. MEDICAL CARE

The organizing committee will provide Medical care and first-aid for all participants during the entire event.

### 10. DOPING CONTROL

Doping control shall be conducted in accordance with AIBA Rules and following the World Anti-Doping Code.

### 11. MEDALS

Gold, Silver and 2 (two) Bronze Medals will be awarded along with diplomas to the winners in each weight category.

### 12. VISA

Those countries, who need Russian visa should contact **in advance** with Embassy of Russia in their countries or with nearest Consulate in neighbour countries. Also we kindly ask you to send to Boxing Federation of Russia **copies of passports** of all members of delegation and the full list of delegation. Please inform us in what city you will apply for Russian visa.
